# CONSENT ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND FOR STAY

This matter is before the Court on PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION.

In this action, Plaintiffs challenge the legality of an Ordinance the Board of Commissioners of Cherokee County, Georgia passed on December 5, 2006, Ordinance No. 2006-003, the stated purpose of which was "to establish penalties for the harboring of illegal aliens in Cherokee County, to promote the public health safety and welfare, and for other purposes." (The "Ordinance"). The effective date of the Ordinance was January 1, 2007. Plaintiffs challenge the Ordinance on the ground that the Ordinance may violate numerous provisions of the United States Constitution and the Georgia Constitution of 1983, as well as federal and state law.

Through their Motion, Plaintiffs seek an interlocutory order under Rule 65 Fed. R. Civ. P. to enjoin Defendant Cherokee County's implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance during the pendency of this action. In light of this lawsuit and Motion, Cherokee County is amenable to avoiding any further expense for all parties associated with pursuing injunctive relief and is willing to consent to this Motion without making any admissions as to the validity of Plaintiffs' claims.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Cherokee County, its officers, agents, employees and attorneys are restrained and enjoined from implementing or enforcing the Ordinance during the pendency of this case or until further order of this Court.

With the parties' consent, and to insure a just and inexpensive determination of this action, IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all proceedings in this case are stayed until a final judgment is entered and appeal avenues pursued in the prior pending cases referenced below or until further order of this Court.<sup>1</sup>

Because the parties have consented to this order the Court deems it proper that a minimum security of \$10 be posted by Plaintiffs.
